Standard 3: Identify

Collect information: Collect information from all planners, faculty, and others in control of educational content about **all** their financial relationships with ineligible companies within the prior **24** months.

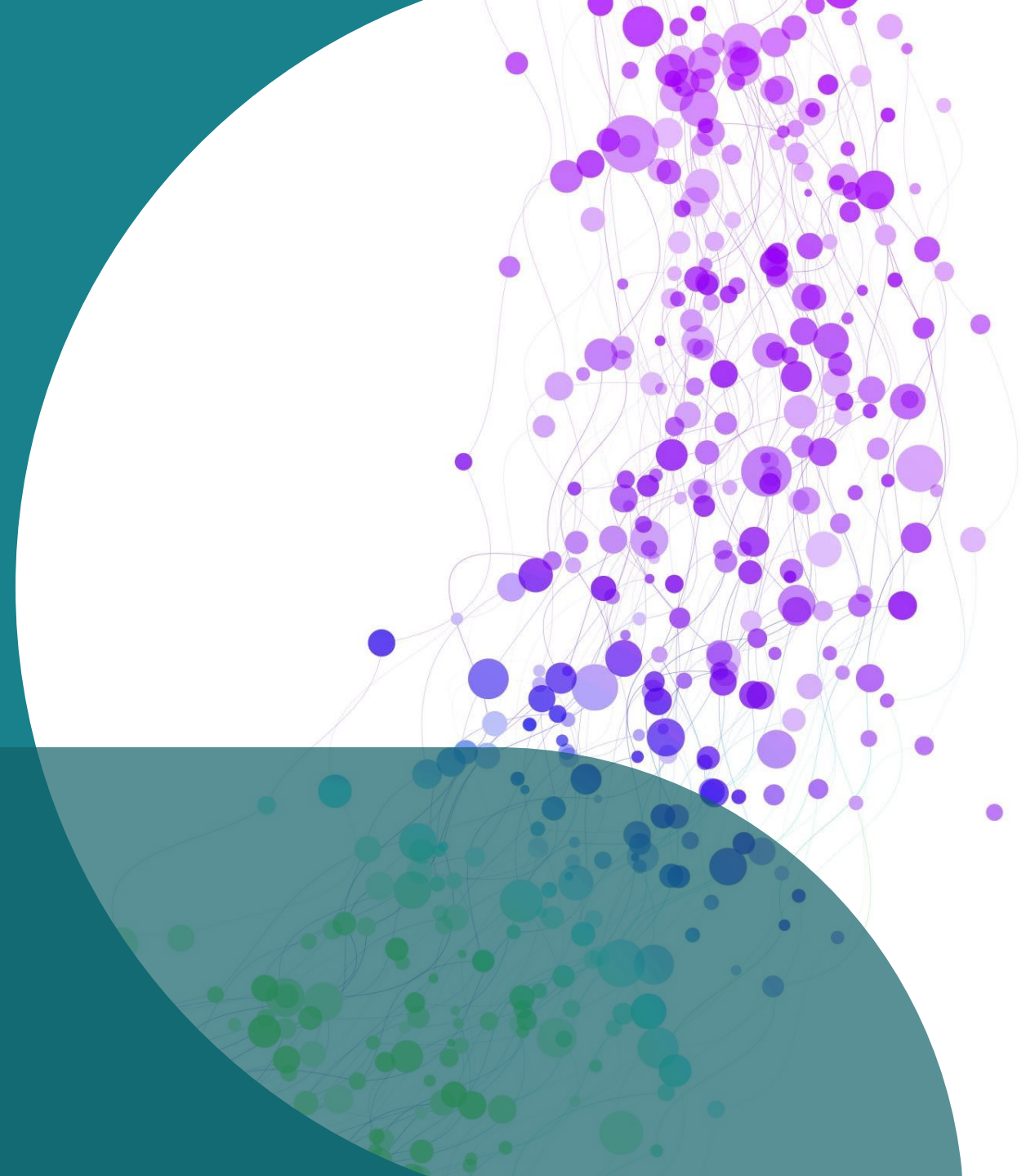

Who is controlling what is being learned?

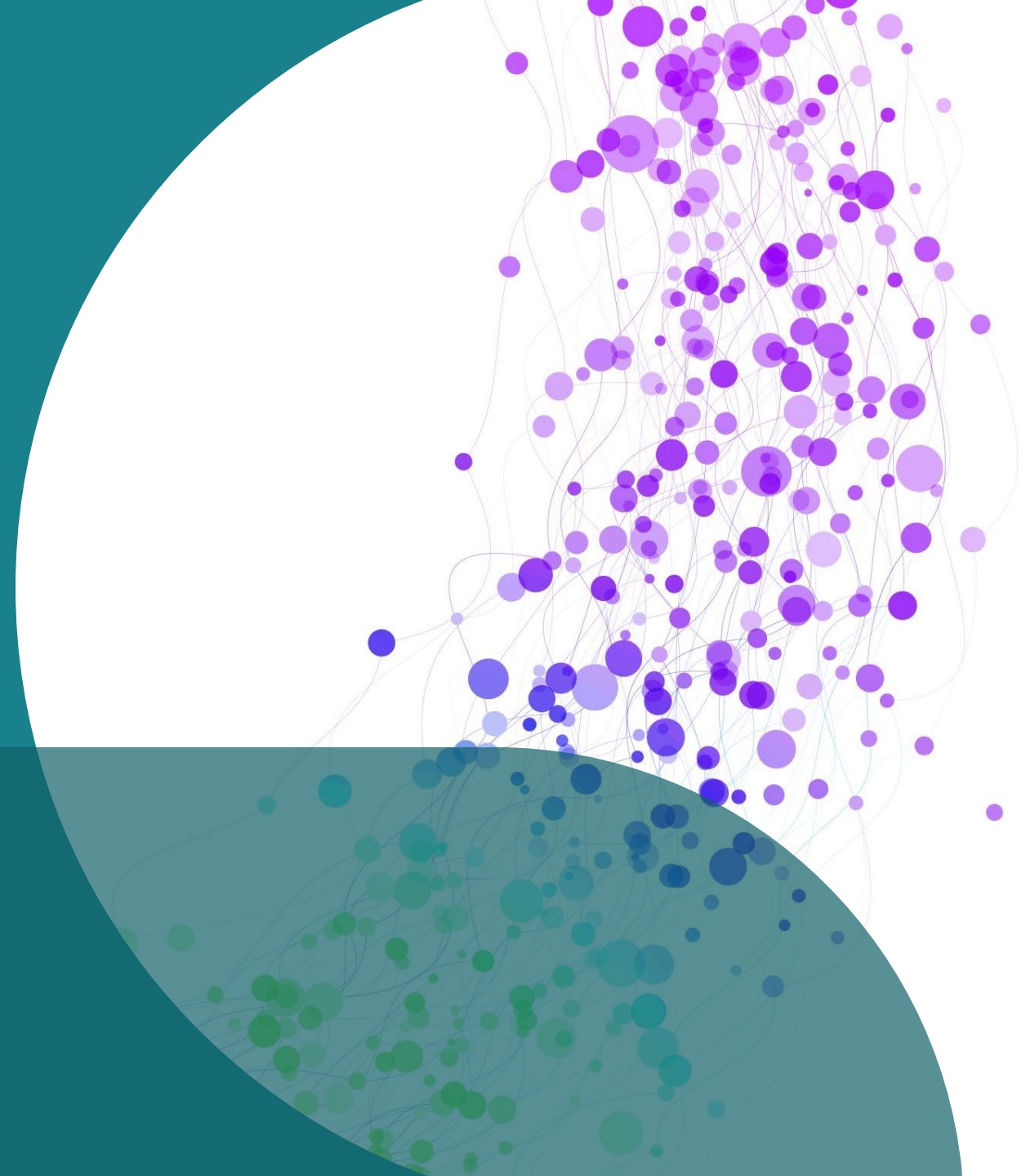
